9-17-77 at approximately 1630 hours this writer was approached by an individual who related to this writer that he was an attorney for the UFW, and wanted to see the subjects that had been arrested in San Ardo.

This writer advised the subject that the persons that he wished to see were not booked at this time, but as soon as the booking process was finished and we were done with our work, I would be glad to let him see them.

At this time the individual became very boistrous and started using foul language. This writer then advised the subject again that he was not going to see the individuals until our work was finished. Again, the subject s started using foul language directed at this writer, such as "Fuck you man", "I demand to see them right now", "You show me in the Constitution where it says I can't see my clients". At this time I related to the individual that I was not refusing him access to his clients, just that we were in the process of booking and as soon as we were through with that process, I would be glad to let him talk with them. Again the individual started his foul language again directed at this writer. At this time I advised the subject that he would have to leave, that he was disrupting the entire jail and staff in their work. Again, he related to this writer, "Fuck you man", I don't have to leave, at this time I again asked the subject to leave. Again he refused. At this time the subject was placed under arrest for violation; of section 148 PC and placed inside of the jail.

The subject was resisting at the time of arrest and had to be physically restrained to ~~XXX~~ effect the arrest. The subject was kicking out and swinging his arms and using foul language. When the arrest was completed the force necessary to effect the arrest was stopped.

At this time the subject was searched and then placed in the issolation cell for safe keeping. We had no other cell for individual isolation. After the search had been completed the individual was identified as an attorney and his name was Stanford NATHAN.

At this time this writer called Judge Moreno and advised him of the

Judge Moreno then left the jail and advised this writer that if there were any further confrontations with the subjects to call him.

At approximately 1900 hours all the clients and three UFW attorneys were placed into the interview room where the interview was completed.

Subject NATHAN was released from the Monterey County Jail without first being booked per order of Judge Moreno.

9-17-77, approximately 1630 hours this writer was working as a booking officer at the Monterey County Jail. This writer heard loud talking and screaming coming from the front lobby of the jail. This writer left the booking room and proceeded through the front office into the lobby where I observed a white male subject talking very loud, and creating a disturbance. While talking to my supervisor Sgt. Rosa, demanding to see his clients that had been arrested. Sgt. Rosa tried to reason with the subject. NATHAN in that he would let him see his clients as soon as they were booked, but NATHAN continued to demand to see his clients, using abusive language, shouting and creating a disturbance in the jail lobby.

At this time Sgt. Rosa asked NATHAN to leave the jail. NATHAN refused to leave, stating that he was not leaving the jail and that if Sgt. Rosa wanted him out of the jail he would have to throw him out. Once again, Sgt. Rosa asked NATHAN to leave the jail and again NATHAN refused.

At this time Sgt. Rosa placed NATHAN under arrest and instructed C.C. Graham C. C. Salviejo and I to pat search NATHAN. This writer moved toward NATHAN and attempted to pat search NATHAN when he swung around as if to hit this writer and call me a bastard. At this time this writer restrained NATHAN and took him inside the jail and continued the search, it should be noted that NATHAN did not have papers or identification in his possession identifying him as a lawyer.

Rosa talking to a male subject. This unidentified subject appeared very hostile toward Sgt. Rosa. This unidentified subject was standing in the open doorway to the front office shouting at Sgt. Rosa. From what I could understand Sgt. Rosa was trying to explain to this subject that he couldn't see anyone until he/she was completely booked into the jail facility. Deputies Oliver, Graham, and Leininger were with Sgt. Rosa.

See that enough deputies were there inside the front office, I returned to the booking office where I continued to process people. A few minutes later I heard a scuffle in the hallway. I looked out and saw deputies Oliver & Graham trying to subdue the above mentioned male. This person was resisting the efforts of the deputies. Deputies Oliver and Graham took this person down to his knees and was restrained. He was then placed in the isolation cell.

9-17-77 approximately 1630 hours this writer was using the Sgt. Office as a booking station as we were extremely busy, when I heard a subject in the lobby area of the jail demanding to see his clients.

I also heard Sgt. Rosa advise the subject who I later learned was a Mr. NATHAN, that he could see his clients as soon as they were booked. Mr. NATHAN became irate and was yelling that he was going to see them (his clients) right then. I also heard Sgt. Rosa ask Mr. NATHAN to leave the area several times.

I finished with the subject whom I was booking and was taking him back to the booking cell when I heard a commotion in the lobby area.

I proceeded to the main booking office where I observed several officers struggling with Mr. NATHAN. I activated the door to the jail which allowed the officers to bring Mr. NATHAN into the jail. Mr. NATHAN was then placed in the isolation cell.

9-17-77 approximately 1630 hours, Stanford Norman NATHAN approached this officer and inquired about the United Farm Workers in custody. He stated to this officer that he wanted to know when they would be OR'd and this writer stated that there would be no ORs at this time unless I was instructed otherwise. At this time Sgt. Rosa approached the subject and asked him what he wanted. A conversation ensued outside the jail office which I could not hear, for approximately five minutes. Sgt. Rosa returned to the office at this time and NATHAN followed closely shouting at Sgt. Rosa to allow and demand that he see the arrested inmates now. Sgt. Rosa advised NATHAN in a calm manner that when the inmates were booked he would be allowed to see them. NATHAN replied "Fuck you man, I demand to see them now and it is their constitutional right". Again, Sgt. Rosa replied "You may see them when they are booked and ready". NATHAN replied "No way man I demand to see them now as I am their appointed attorney". At this time Sgt. Rosa called Judge Moreno and advised him the rude and belligerent manner of NATHAN. Then Sgt. Rosa asked NATHAN to please leave the building and NATHAN said "Fuck you man, what law am I breaking?" Sgt. Rosa replied "My order as a police officer". NATHAN replied, "I can stay here all night if I want to". Again, Sgt. Rosa asked NATHAN to leave and NATHAN refused.

At this time Sgt. Rosa placed NATHAN under arrest for 148 PC and NATHAN had to be physically placed inside the jail and detained in the isolation cell to cool off. NATHAN at no time offered to Sgt. Rosa any identification as to his credibility of being an attorney to this writer's knowledge.

9-17-77 approximately 1630 hours, I heard a lot of yelling and screaming coming from the office area. Immediately, I went into that particular area, where I observed a NATHAN, Stanford demanding to see the Mexican prisoners that were brought in. Sgt. Rosa explained to the subject several times, that after they were booked, he could talk to them. Subject NATHAN screamed that "I don't give a fuck about your booking, they have their rights, and I want to see them now". Sgt. Rosa called Judge Moreno twice and explained what was going on.

The outside visiting area had quite a few people and the subject was making a spectacle of himself. Yelling demands at Sgt. Rosa, and simultaneously bouncing his finger off Sgt. Rosa's chest. At that time I moved to the right side of Mr. NATHAN. Sgt. Rosa again, one last time explained the jail procedure to the subject, adding that if he didn't cool his actions and wait until after booking, that the subject would also be booked on a 148 PC charge. This only made the subject more irate, so the subject was physically brought inside the hallway. He was searched for weapons, and his personal property was taken from him. At this time he was placed in the isolation cell.
